Job Descriptions

AREAS OF INTEREST

Puppy Raiser

Volunteer will be responsible for the physical, financial, and emotional care of a service dog in training. From approximately two months to sixteen months of age. The main duties include providing positive socialization and teaching basic and intermediate commands. Must be available for puppy 24/7

Puppy Sitter

When a puppy raiser is on vacation, has an emergency or just needs a break. Time frame: anywhere from two hours a month to a week.

Special Events

Demonstrations & Education

This is a great way for graduates to be involved. It is also nice to be able to take young puppies in training and advanced dogs and teach people what service dogs actually do for their partners. Presentations to schools and other venues are generally one hour events.

Arts and Crafts

Volunteers help by sewing/making dog toys, and sewing items for our bow-tique. The time commitment can be anywhere from a couple hours a month to above and beyond that you are willing to donate. CaPR supplies materials.

Photography

Be at events and classes and shoot some pictures to add to our virtual photo gallery. Commitment can run from attending a one day event to fulfilling this role over several months.

Phone Calls

Do you enjoy spending time on the phone? CaPR has the right volunteer job for you-- to call other volunteers and participants in upcoming events to assure great communication in the

organization. This responsibility could take five minutes a week to four to five hours prior to a big event.

Grooming

Willingness to bathe, brush, or cut toe nails as needed. Commitment can run from a half hour a month to a couple of hours.

Carpentry

Are you handy with a rotary saw and enjoy being creative. CaPR needs individuals to help make elevated dog bowls for auctions, and light switch panels for advance trainers and demos. You volunteer the number of hours you want and anytime you'd like.

Enjoy stuffing envelopes while you relax. This could be the right volunteer job for you. CaPR has three annual newsletters that go out and small mailings in between. Assist in set-up, take down, refreshments, and ect. As needed to provide maximum time for trainers to work with the candidates for future graduation. Anytime you can commit to from one day to the whole two weeks would be great.

Graduate Assistance (as needed)

Involves circumstances such as running a graduates dog to the vet, scooper brigade duties, helping to exercise the dog, and other events that the graduate feels a need for assistance. The time frame on this opportunity will vary greatly.
